

Decorate the Human

Object:

The object of this game is to remind the students that God is the Creator, and He has perfect plans for each of us. He had a perfect plan to send His one and only Son Jesus to die for our sins. Jesus overcame sin and overcame death. He defeated sin and death so that we may have eternal life.

Supplies:

- Multiple colors of crepe paper per group
- Tape
- Scissors
- Glue

Preparation:

Give each team their different colors of crepe paper

How to Play:

Explain to students that they will be divided into groups of 6-8. The goal for this game is to have one volunteer from each group be decorated by their team. The team with their human covered the most and the most creatively wins!

Leader Script:

Each of us has a purpose for God's kingdom. God has a hope and a future for each of His children. Sometimes His plans are not our plans. His plan for each person is unique and different.
